

PRIVACY POLICY OF THE URBAN WATERSHEDS RESEARCH INSTITUTE, INC.

Urban Watersheds Research Institute, Inc. (UWRI) respects the privacy of our clients, donors and other visitors to our web site. To protect online privacy, UWRI has implemented the following policy which may be amended at any time and reposted on this web page.

What Information Does UWRI Collect?

UWRI collects data to better serve our clients and donors. It is our policy to collect and store only information that will permit us to best serve our clients, donors and visitors that were knowingly provided by them.

Information from Web Site Visitors. UWRI does not collect any information from visitors browsing our web site. Visitors to the public areas of UWRI's web site browse anonymously. UWRI may collect aggregate data from all users browsing our web site for purposes of statistical analysis of web site traffic, which data may be used only for internal and marketing purposes without collecting or providing any personal identification information.

Information from UWRI Class, seminar and Conference Registrants, Donors and Other Customers. There are areas on the UWRI web site that when you register, provide a donation or order a product we ask for and collect information about you, including personally identifiable information in order to serve you better, or is necessary to accomplish the service you are requesting. Examples may include name, address, e-mail, telephone number and educational and professional affiliation, class, conference and seminar registrations, security identifiers.

Contact information is used by UWRI only to generate UWRI mailing lists for the purpose of notifying of upcoming events and activities, to provide other information about UWRI and to contact donors.

Third Party Disclosure. UWRI does not sell or rent any postal or e-mail addresses to anyone outside of UWRI and its organizational entities. From time to time, to better serve our clients and donors, the UWRI mailing list, in part or as a whole, may be released to carefully selected third party organizations to provide you with information on technical information and products and services related to your profession. You may instruct us not to share information about you in the UWRI mailing list with third parties by contacting us indicating this preference by e-mail to info@urbanwatersheds.org, or by calling us at 303-728-4449.

Secure Transactions. For your protection, we have taken a number of steps to maximize the security of financial transactions that are accepted on the UWRI web site. Credit Card processing for all UWRI activities, including processing of credit cards by UWRI class and event registration contracted services, are accomplished using secure processing services. Your entry of credit card information is encrypted when transmitted in secure mode. If for any reason you still feel uncomfortable submitting your credit card over the Internet, you can mail your information to us.
